
## 8.2 Student Branches' Corner ASHRAE CityU Student Branch

Technical Seminar on "Building a Net Zero Lab in the United Arab Emirates: Mission Impossible?"



AHRAE Hong Kong Chapter had joint organized a technical seminar with HKIE BSD and CIBSE, titled "Building a Net Zero Lab in the United Arab Emirates: Mission Impossible?" on 28 September 2017 (Thursday) in a lecture theatre FJ304, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University.

In this evening, around 77 participants attended the technical seminar. In the beginning, Chapter Program Chair, delivered a welcoming address to all participants and introduced the background of honorable speaker, Gordon P. Sharp, who

is Distinguished Lecturer of ASHRAE.

During the seminar, Mr. Sharp highlighted several key design features and engineering concepts on high efficiency laboratory. He also shared his project experience in designing a net zero lab in extreme climate for consideration

in building sustainability.

Being interested in the globally concerned engineering topic, participants raised questions for more details in laboratory designs and their implementation in the Q&A session. the corresponding benefits. It aims at attracting potential members




to join our big family continuously.


