Programme Highlight:

<u>Can a modern building satisfy sustainability?</u> Refrigerating and air conditioning have been listed on the top ten technical achievements of the last century. Some kind of air conditioning was already used in the ancient Egypt and insulation was known during in the Roman period. This talk will cover the old and newest facades including the double-facades and their thermal characteristics. Following a discussion of air-conditioning history, this lecture also reviews the historic influences, the structure of energy consumption, the relationship between production and import of energy, the needs of energy for heating for modern buildings in typical European towns, district heating systems, the energy balance of big cities, tariff policy and energy consumption.

About the Speaker:

Dr. Todorovic received his training in Mechanical Engineering from the University in Belgrade and the Technical University in Berlin. He is a professor at the University in Belgrade, and has been a visiting professor at the University of Vienna in Austria, the University of California in Berkeley, and California State University in San Jose. He is also a full professor with tenure at the University of Kansas. He published 170 scientific papers, wrote 16 books, designed 72 HVAC projects, and completed 32 research projects. His papers are cited in 159 papers of other authors and in the ASHRAE Fundamentals chapter on Cooling Load. He has lectured on 52 universities in Europe, Australia, and the U.S.

Professor Todorovic is a member of Academy of Engineers of Serbia and Montenegro, the Hungarian Scientific Society for Building and Architecture, and the Russian Academy of Architectural and Building Science. He is an ASHRAE Fellow, Honorary Member of the Serbian Engineering Society, and an Honorary Member of the European Heating Society REHVA. He has served as ASHRAE Director-at-Large, and former President of the European Society REHVA.



Among his many awards are the ASHRAE Best Paper Award, ASHRAE Award of Merit, ASHRAE Awards for International Activity and the Distinguished Service Award. He is now Vice President of the Executive Committee of the International Institute of Refrigeration in Paris, Editor of the International Journal Energy & Buildings published by Elsevier, Director in the Serbian Ministry for Science and Technology for Energy Efficiency in Buildings, and a member of the ASHRAE Journal Committee.
