#### **Programme Highlights**

One of the main objectives of water treatment in waterside air conditioning system is to soften the water hardness and thus minimize scale formation. Other than the conventional chemical water treatment method, physical water treatment is an alternative for controlling scale deposits in heat exchangers and pipeworks of waterside air conditioning systems. Two physical water treatment technologies will be introduced to highlight their respective operation principles and design considerations. An example of applying physical water treatment for controlling scale of existing air conditioning plant will also be given.

#### **Speaker**

Mr. L.C. SHEK, is currently an engineer in the Energy Efficiency Office of the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department. He joined the Energy Efficiency Office in 1996 and since then he has been actively participated in administration and implementation of various initiatives for widen promotion of energy-efficient water-cooled air conditioning systems in Hong Kong.

Mr. Shek completed the Engineering Council Part II Examinations in 1992 and obtained the BSc in Economics (External Degree) in 1992.
