Programme Highlights

The “Technical Guidelines on Grid Connection of Renewable Energy Power Systems” is published to provide an outline on various technical issues relating to the connection of renewable energy power systems (REPS) to the grid through the distribution system of the building concerned. It also serves as a quick reference to establish the technical requirements for developing any prospective grid-connected renewable energy power systems proposal. The 1st edition of the guidelines was issued in year 2005. With the contributions from the trade and the industry, the 2nd edition (i.e. the 2007 edition) has been issued recently. This technical talk will brief the history of the development of the guidelines, typical examples of grid-connected REPS and revisions in the guidelines.

He is responsible for the promotion of energy efficiency and renewable energy installations in Hong Kong and providing technical advice on such installations.
