**Details**

Ionisation air treatment has gained a very wide application in the engineering field to improve air quality. It not only improve the indoor air quality in air conditioned buildings but can also be used to disinfect food processing areas, hospital wards, nursing homes, and up to treating exhaust emissions from kitchens, garbage areas, toilets and sewerage treatment plants, etc.

This type of system has already been widely adopted in buildings in Hong Kong. The system can also be found in a number of Refuse Sorting Centers. The technical detail requirements are clearly stated in the "General Specifications for Government Buildings" as well as in the "General Specifications for Refuse Storage & Collection Buildings" in Hong Kong. The government of the United Arab Emirates in the Middle East is currently considered to stipulate similar government regulations for enhancing Public Health, Food Safety and Environmental Health. This is not only a concern to the UAE government but equally applicable to all governments elsewhere.

**Speaker**

Mr. Philipp Leicher has a degree in Bachelor of Commerce & Economics, and he has 25 years experience in the design and manufacture of air purification equipment, and is very familiar with different type of available air purification technology. He will compare the pros and cons of the different types of air purification technologies on the market in Hong Kong. The speaker will present test reports on the system removal of bacteria, RSP, odor, Nicotine, Ammonia, Formaldehyde, Hydrogen sulphide, Acetaldehyde and other chemical pollutant. In particular he will also present some of the recent results in dealing with the smoking room ventilation in a Macau casino.
