Smoke has long been considered as a silent killer during the fire accident. Peoples are most often killed by inhaling toxic smoke rather than direct burning. Under such consideration, a smoke control system should not be undermined in its effectiveness in handling properly the smoke generation, creating high visibility for the environment, minimizing the temperature built up and toxicity in such a way that tenability conditions can always be maintained for evacuation. This technical talk will discuss the principles need to be considered when designing an effective smoke control system and how they can be practically applied in the projects.
