Guangzhou University City
Jointly organized by HKIE BSD, ASHRAE HKC, and CIBSE HKB

Date : 4 March 2006 (Saturday)

Programme Highlight :

Guangzhou University City (GUC) is located at Panyu of Guangdong occupying a land of 43.3 sq.km. In GUC there are 10 universities which can accommodate up to 180,000-200,000 students, and up to 350,000-400,000 residents. Its scale is comparable to a city. The total construction cost is estimated to be around RMB 30 billion. It adopted the concept of Resources Sharing including the facilities such as district cooling systems and ice storage cooling plants with capacity up to 100,000 Ton of Refrigeration. The visit will start at the South China University of Technology where the designer of the central cooling plants will provide a briefing of the system design, and then the tour will visit the major plants of the GUC. Transportation from Hong Kong to the GUC and return, and lunch will be provided. The visit will last for a whole day.
