Tai Kok Tsui Municipal Services Building is a 8-storey multi-purpose building that accommodates a number of facilities including:

- market;
- cooked food center;
- public library;
- indoor swimming pool;
- leisure facilities, and
- arena.

The gross floor area is about 19,000m<sup>2</sup>. The visit will cover specific building services systems such as Swimming Pools Filtration Plant with CCMS automatic control, Heat Pump Desiccant Dehumidification, Water Scrubbers and IAQ equipment. Furthermore, a briefing on energy review of the building will be given.
