When completed in 2010, the International Commerce Centre ("ICC") located above Kowloon Station in Hong Kong, will become the 3rd tallest building in the world and the tallest in Hong Kong (489 mPD). Jointly developed by Sun Hung Kai Properties and MTR Corporation, ICC will include 2.5 million square feet of Grade A office space, an Observation Deck and the six-star Ritz Carlton Hotel.

The program begins with an overview of the vision, design and development of the project and its building services provisions presented by key members of the development team. Next enjoy a guided tour of ICC with a focus on the building's pioneering engineering, environmental and technology features.
