Programme Highlight:

AIG Tower, located in Central, on the site of former Furama Hotel, comprises 37 levels including 2 levels of basement carpark, public walkway and sky lobby, refuge and mechanical floors, and 26 floors of prime grade "A" office accommodation, ranging from 1,300 to 1,800 square meters, and a total gross floor area of approximately 39,000 square meters. AIG Tower got a Merit in Quality Building Award 2008.

Sustainable design and energy efficiency was one of the major considerations in the design of AIG Tower. The main sustainable design features include fully unitized curtain wall with double-glazed low-e insulated glass units and sun shading device, solar hot water system for washrooms, natural lighting and ventilation at the Footbridge, and advanced building management system for energy efficiency of building services systems etc.

The building services designed as the nerve centre of AIG Tower. Dual provisions include drainage connections, high voltage incomers and electrical risers, each capable of providing the full building load, and telecommunication incomers.
