Programme Highlight:

Schneider Busway Guangzhou was initially set up in 1997 in the Guangzhou Economic & Technological Development Zone, PRC. The factory was built to manufacture Square D I-Line Busway to cope with rapid expansion of power network in Greater China and South East Asia. Product lines include *I-Line II Series* high power busway and *Canalis Series* low to medium power busway, which mainly supply for the Asia Pacific and Middle East Markets. The annual production volume reaches 200 km of high power busway in 2007 while the number of employee was about 280. SBG's successful stories include: 2008 Olympic Stadiums (Beijing), Jin Mao Building (Shanghai), General Motors (Shanghai), International Financial Centre 2 (Hong Kong), Venetian Resort (Macau), Siam Paragon (Thailand), Chamber of Commerce (Korea), Toyota Motors (Australia), Mall of Emirates (United Arab Emirates), Cairo Airport Terminal 3 (Egypt), etc.

To cope the growing market needs, SBG has adopted molecular fusion technology in developing high power Copper Contact Busway (Bi-metal Busway) and completed the Seismic (Earthquake Condition) Response Study. A brief presentation on the above achievement will be given during the factory visit.
